Necessity: We will retain your personal data only for the period required to process it.

Security and Confidentiality: We commit to taking the necessary measures to ensure the confidentiality of the data and prevent its disclosure to unauthorised third parties. In the event of a transfer of data to authorised third parties, we will take appropriate measures to guarantee the security of the transfer.

Respecting your rights: You are informed of your access, rectification, and opposition rights in accordance with Law No. 78-17 of 6 January 1978. The details of the relevant department to contact are provided below.
